About the Practicum

This one-week learning session provides specialized instruction in the role of diet and bioactive food components as modifiers of cancer incidence and tumor behavior. The practicum is research based, not clinically based and therefore, it is best suited for those interested in expanding their research applications and applying research to their practice.

Application Requirements

- Title page (see below for what to include in the Title Page)
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Two (2) letters of support from the director of your institute or department, mentors, instructors, supervisors, or preceptors. Letters of recommendations should be viewable to application candidates. Letters should be signed and in pdf format. Letters should be included in packet and not sent separately.
- One (1) page letter of intent, outlining why this practicum is important to your career development, especially related to research in diet and cancer.
- All documents (title page, CV, 2 letters of support, and letter of intent) should be sent together in one pdf document.
